



Texas Chapter Drahn Jones Award for Excellence in Education

Purpose This award recognizes outstanding and meritorious achievement of individuals assisting in the areas of continuing and graduate professional education for public works professionals. . This award is also intended to recognize TPWA branches for their work in delivering educational opportunities for all levels of persons engaged in the delivery of public works services.

Eligibility This award recognizes both individuals and branches. Individual candidates must be APWA members, and branch candidates must have active educational programs

Selection The Awards Committee reviews the nominations and selects the award winners.

Nomination Process

- 1. Individual candidates** Must be nominated by any member of APWA. It is the responsibility of the candidate to furnish supporting documentation.
- 2. Branch candidates** Must submit supporting documentation that outlines the goals and objectives of their educational programs and accomplishments in the previous calendar year. When a branch is selected for this award, they must wait three years before submitting the same educational program, at which time they should show how that program has significantly improved.

Submittal should include nomination form and supporting documentation.

Presentation The award winner(s) are recognized at the Awards Banquet during the TPWA Annual Public Works Conference.
